
Linx Mobile Book Shelving Assembly Instructions

- 1. Place the bottom shelf on a table with the top surface facing down. Using the wood screws, attach the casters using the pre-drilled holes.
- 2. Now place the bottom shelf on the table with the top surface up. From the under side, insert an Allen-headed bolt into any of the holes and hold it with the included wrench. Turn a post onto the bolt and tighten by hand until snug. Do not over tighten. Repeat this step for all four posts.
- **3.** Using your fingers, turn four connecting bolts into the tops of the posts until they stop.
- **4.** Place a shelf over the connecting bolts.
- **5.** Turn four more posts by hand onto the connecting bolts until snug. Again, do not over tighten.
- **6** Repeat steps #4 and #5 for all shelves.
- **7.** To finalize assembly, use the remaining four Allen-headed bolts and fasten the final shelf using the included wrench.

IMPORTANT: It's not recommended to build your shelving unit more than five levels high.

IMPORTANT: It's not recommended to build your shelving unit more than five levels high.
